- In 1980 Roland Butcher became the first black West Indian to play One Day International Cricket for England. This was followed in 1981 with him also becoming the first black West Indian to play Test Cricket for England. His first Test Match for England was against the West Indies in Barbados the place of his birth, at Kensington Oval.
- In his attacking exhibition style twenty year professional career with Middlesex County Cricket Club he scored over 12,000 runs, 17 centuries, winning 6 County Championships and 6 One Day trophies.

- Apart from playing the game he loves Roland is also an English Cricket Board Level 3 Coach and played and coached in Australia, India, Pakistan, Zimbabwe, New Zealand, Bermuda and other countries in Europe as a high Performance Coach for the ICC
- Mr. Butcher is presently the Head Coach at the Academy of Sport UWI Cave Hill Campus, having been the Director of Sports overseeing the development of all sports, a position that he held for nine years since returning from England in 2004 having resided there for 37yrs.

- Mr. Roland Butcher is a Director Barbados Football Association, Director Barbados Cricket Association, Chairman of the Sir Everton Weekes Centre of Excellence, a member of Cricket West Indies Cricket Committee, a member of the BCA Cricket Development Committee, BCA Scholarships Committee, BCA Clubs Assistance Committee, and member of the UWI Cricket Management Committee.
- He also served as a member of the National Sports Council Board, Manager and Coach of the Vice Chancellor's team on different occasions, and the Barbados under fifteen Cricket Team. In addition to being a Level 3 cricket coach, he is also a U.E.F.A (B) License Football Coach and worked in this capacity for 10 years with Arsenal Football Club and Reading Football Club. For the past 10yrs I have worked for the Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) and the Line and Length Network as a cricket and football commentator and analyst on Regional and International sport.

Project our proposals for the growth of cricket

Our project is made up of two parts:

- Coaching academy for coaches.
- Cricket camps for boys and girls aged 8 to 18 years



Project coaching academy

The profession of sports coach, like that of teacher or education, requires frequent, continuing education to keep up with the best and newest methods, tools, and systems. These everimproving methods enable one to do the best possible job and teach others, in our case, to understand the game of cricket.

For that reason, we have designed a coaching academy to pass on those latest methods to those coaching youth cricket teams.

These coaching academy opportunities take place over the course of three days, each having a four hour session divided into one hour lectures taught by coaches from some of the best teams across the world.

The specific timing of each session is flexible, as we will adjust to local times that work best for all attendees. At the end of the three day course, a certificate will be awarded to those who complete it.


Our working methodology has three differentiated areas:

- Coaching: technique and tactics.
- Training: working with bat and ball.
- Strategy: increase knowledge of the game and its strategy

The weekly program of activities (5 days) is as follows:

- Breakfast or afternoon snack with talk about sports nutrition and healthy eating habits.
- 3 Hours of cricket coaching and training every day (15 Hours)
- Talks with coaches about tactics, teamwork and values.

All participants receive gear for training: two t-shirts, shorts, and a baseball hat.
